Invitation

We are a group of scientists at the University of Bristol. We want to find out about Covid in schools and homes. We are asking if you can help us. You need to decide whether to take part. Please read this sheet to help you decide.

Why do we want to find out about Covid in schools and homes?

We want to help schools and families to stop Covid spreading. We want to help schools stay open.

Why have you asked me?

Your spit sample taken at school tested positive for Covid. We would like to check other people you know to see if they might also have Covid. You may also be asked to be part of this study if someone else in your house tested positive (a brother or sister or an adult who works in a school).

Do I have to take part?

You do not have to take part. You can decide with your parent or carer. If you say yes, you can change your mind later.

What will it involve?

Every week for four weeks a test kit will be sent to your home. You and your family will each spit into a tube, just like you did at school (if you were part of the Schools Study). Your parent or carer will send the kit back to the researchers. The samples will be used to check whether anyone has Covid or whether anyone has had it in the past and got better.



Who will know my test results?

We will tell your parent or carer the results of the test. We may tell your Headteacher.
